OHS Mock Election

- You have a chance to participate in a school-wide presidential election
- You will have the opportunity to vote on computers (if they are in your classroom) after CHAMPS or on your phone if the teacher allows
- There will also be computers available for voting during lunch, thanks to your Leadership representatives
- The next few slides provide details on the candidates and are arranged in alphabetical order by last name





The Candidates: Hillary Clinton

- Party: Democratic
- Professional Highlights: US Secretary of State (2009-13), US Senator for New York (2001-09), First Lady of the US (1993-2001), Lawyer (1976-92), Lawyer for the House Judiciary Committee investigating President Richard M. Nixon (1974)
- Education: Wellesley College and Yale Law School
- Issues:
 - Hopes to raise the federal minimum wage to \$12/hour
 - Wants the wealthiest Americans to pay higher taxes
 - Supports immigration reform and protections for certain groups of undocumented immigrants
 - Believes climate change is an “urgent threat”
 - Supports expanding background checks for purchasing weapons and banning assault weapons



The Candidates: Gary Johnson

- Party: Libertarian (former Republican)
- Professional Highlights: Started work as a door-to-door handyman and turned this work into a multi-million dollar corporation, Governor of New Mexico (1995-2003, as a Republican)
- Education: University of New Mexico
- Issues:
 - Plans to reduce the national debt and reforming the tax code to encourage saving and investing
 - Believes that dealing with immigration will not be as easy as building a wall or offering amnesty
 - Worries about climate change and that politicians are creating ineffective policies to prevent it
 - Argues that “people, not politicians, should make choices in their personal lives”



The Candidates: Evan McMullin

- Party: Independent (former Republican)
- Professional Highlights: CIA, Investor at Goldman Sachs, senior advisor for national security issues for the House Committee on Foreign Affairs
- Education: Brigham Young University, Masters of Business Administration from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania
- Issues:
 - Plans to aid the economy by revising the tax code to help small businesses, to reduce regulations, and to limit costly government programs
 - Addresses immigration by solidifying borders and legalizing immigrants in the country
 - Promotes innovation to find better resources to limit climate change
 - Supports the right to own guns but believes in paying attention to the FBI watch list



The Candidates: Jill Stein

- Party: Green
- Professional Highlights: Medical doctor who has served on numerous committees to promote healthier environments so people can be healthier, elected to the Lexington Town Meeting
- Education: Harvard University and Harvard Medical School
- Issues:
 - Hopes to increase minimum wage and support businesses with
 - Supports open paths to citizenship and the end of deportations of law-abiding undocumented immigrants
 - Will enact an emergency Green New Deal to reverse climate change
 - Promotes the end of military grade weapons owned by citizens or used by police



The Candidates: Donald Trump

- Party: Republican
- Professional Highlights: Chairman and president of the Trump Organization (1971-present), Host and co-producer of *The Apprentice* and *The Celebrity Apprentice* (2004-15, 2008-15), author of 15 books
- Education: Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania
- Issues:
 - Plans to renegotiate trade and increase tariffs on imported goods from China
 - Will build a wall (paid by Mexico) on the US-Mexico border to stop illegal immigration
 - Believes climate change is a “total hoax” and supports current oil company practices
 - Opposes expanding background checks on buying weapons and does not believe in banning particular guns; does think those on terror watch lists shouldn’t be allowed to buy weapons
