WHAT RESPECT LOOKS LIKE AT OHS

Students:

- Call staff by their professional name
- Stop immediately when staff addresses you in the hallway
- Do not use curse words EVER

- Understand that learning is the priority at OHS and don't do anything that takes away from the learning environment in or out of class

CLOTHING THAT CANNOT BE WORN:

- Clothing that reveals back, chest, stomach, cleavage, undergarments
- Any clothing with words or pictures that may be offensive to students/staff
- Anything with the "Straight Out of O-Town" or Straight Out of _____"
- · Hats or hoods of any kind in the building during the school day



- Graphics/symbols on clothing, items, or skin that staff member deems inappropriate or disruptive to learning environment due to content, implied meaning, or drug/gang affiliation
- Rosaries may not be worn outside of clothing
- All shirts must have sleeves



- Professional sports team clothing/items are <u>not</u> allowed; college team clothing/items <u>are</u> allowed
- Chest, back, stomach, and backside should be covered completely.
 Skin and undergarments cannot be visible, even through clothing



- Necklines cannot dip below the straight line made across the chest
 - when crossing from one armpit to another
- All shorts, skirts, dresses, and tunics (long shirts) must come within 2 inches of the knee



- All clothing must fit correctly; no sagging, baggy, or extremely tight clothing to include yoga pants and athletic wear unless worn under tunics, dresses or skirts that come within 2 inches of the knee
- No holes or rips (even intentional rips with/without layers underneath)
 are allowed in pants, shorts, or shirts.
- No slippers, house shoes, pajamas or pajama bottoms allowed



DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS WILL BE SENT IMMEDIATELY TO THE OFFICE OF STUDENT CONDUCT AND CANNOT RETURN TO CLASS UNTIL THEY ARE APPROPRIATELY DRESSED – CLOTHING IS THEN KEPT IN THE OFFICE UNTIL THE END OF THE DAY

REPEATED VIOLATIONS LEAD TO DISCIPLINE

<u>NOTE:</u> PUTTING A SWEATER ON OR ZIPPING A JACKET IS NOT AN OPTION FOR FIXING

THE VIOLATION

HEADPHONES/EARBUDS

- Headphones/Earbuds cannot be used <u>OR</u> visible on campus EXCEPT in class WITH
 - **TEACHER PERMISSION**
- This includes:
 - Before and after school
 - Lunch time
 - Between classes
- If a <u>teacher</u> allows you to use headphones/earbuds in class, they will remind you/you will remember before the bell rings that it's time to put them away out of site BEFORE you leave class
- If headphones/earbuds are seen in class <u>without teacher permission</u> or <u>anywhere on campus</u>, staff will confiscate them and have them delivered to the office immediately, where they will be logged and locked up until you pick them up at the office at the end of the day. After the first violation, your parent/guardian will be required to pick it up.





CELL PHONES/MP3/IPODS



Cell phones only allowed to be used and seen in class <u>WITH TEACHER</u> <u>PERMISSION</u>. They can be used in the hall and at lunch, but never for taking pictures, video, or playing music.





If phone is seen in class <u>WITHOUT TEACHER PERMISSION</u>, staff will confiscate it and have it delivered to the office immediately, where it will be logged and locked up until you pick it up at the office at the end of the day. After the first violation, your parent/guardian will be required to pick it up.



PICTURES & VIDEO & MUSIC

 Taking video or pictures on any electronic device on campus from 7:30-3:30 or during any after school classes is <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> unless given staff permission



 Listening to music on any device is <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> on campus from 7:30-3:30 or during any after school classes unless given staff permission







• If you are seen taking pictures/video or listening to music without teacher permission, staff will confiscate the device and have it delivered to the office immediately, where it will be logged and locked up until you pick it up at the office at the end of the day. After the first violation, your parent/guardian will be required to pick it up.



PDA (PUBLIC DISPLAY OF AFFECTION)





- Students may not kiss, have romantic or long hugs, or have arms around one another in any way on school campus
- Holding hands is permitted, but only outside of class and only if it doesn't block anyone in the hallway



THESE RULES APPLY TO EVERYONE IN ALL SITUATIONS, REGARDLESS OF RELATIONSHIP

Staff will support this expectation by sending anyone doing this to the Office of Student Conduct immediately.

BEFORE SCHOOL



- <u>Doors open at OHS at 7:30</u> students are not allowed in the building before that time
 - If athletes are here for an early practice that ends prior to 7:30, they are required to leave the building and return when the doors open –they cannot wait in a classroom, locker room, or gym
 - Voice Level 2 in halls and Tiger Hall at all times
 - Nobody in the gym without teacher permission and supervision
 - A reminder no pictures, videos, music, or headphones allowed
 - On late start Wednesdays, doors do not open until 8:30 and students cannot be in the building before that time



- Staff will make sure students are not in classrooms or the building prior to 7:30 and 8:30 on late start Wednesdays
- Staff will actively supervise their assigned areas and classrooms, locking classrooms if they will be gone for an extended period of time in the morning



AFTER SCHOOL



- All students must be in a classroom for work, club activity, or athletics by 3:00
 when the halls must be cleared and the exterior doors are locked
- Voice Level 2
- A reminder no pictures, videos, music or headphones allowed
- Students attending Night School may work in a classroom until 3:30 with a teacher or work in Computer Lab in the 200 Hall with Ms. Meeks until 3:30 and then attend night school



Staff members will be in assigned locations to actively supervise and assist you as you travel to a classroom, athletics, or leave the building by 3:00, making sure the halls are cleared. They will also log anyone still in class after 4:00.



WHEN LEAVING THE BUILDING ...

...AFTER HOMEWORK HELP OR NIGHT SCHOOL, YOU MUST LEAVE OUT THE NEAREST EXIT, NOT RETURNING TO YOUR LOCKER IN ANOTHER HALL. YOU CANNOT WALK THROUGH THE BUILDING.

IF YOU ARE IN THE BUILDING

....AND THE DOORS ARE LOCKED AND SOMEONE IS TRYING TO GET IN, YOU MAY NOT OPEN THE DOOR. THERE WILL BE NO SUPERVISION AND THE DOORS ARE LOCKED FOR A REASON—

DO NOT OPEN THEM FOR ANYONE!
